### **Install WordPress**

You can start with the [installation of WordPress](#) in the sub-directory of Magento. Do not install Magento in a sub directory that also contains your blogs from WordPress.

### **Configure**

It is a fairly simple process to connect your WordPress database to Magento. You can begin with logging in with admin credentials, select WordPress-> Choose Settings from the navigation pane and complete the form inside Database and integration section. Complete the information that is required in the database section of WordPress Database. You can get all the information in wp-config.php file which is saved in the root of your WordPress installation.

### **Integration**

The first setting will be about integrating [WordPress into your Magento theme](#). If you want to integrate themes then you will see an additional field called blog route. Now enter the

sub directory where you want your blog to be seen. Whatever name you give to this field will be appended to the home page URL. Upload the URL for your homepage on WordPress which will disable WordPress to be the front end of your blogs as it is being displayed through another application. If you don't follow this step, your blog will be visible in 2 different locations simultaneously. Login to your WordPress and go to the General tab in settings. Enter the Magento URL as your blog homepage in the field known as 'site address'.

The process will be completed when the path will be integrated with the WordPress field. Enter the name of the sub directory where you installed WordPress in Magento.

Your steps to integrate Magento with WordPress are now complete and you must check if it is working properly. You can go to the Magento Extensions to see all the options that have been made available to enhance the quality of your blog and the subsequent experience.
